1. Acceptance of Terms

By creating an account or using www.politex.uk (the "Platform"), you agree to be bound by these Terms of Service ("Terms"). If you do not agree, do not use the Platform.

These Terms form a legally binding agreement between you and Ludus Games Ltd ("we", "us", "our"), a company registered in England and Wales (17331322).

2. About Politex

Politex is a paper trading platform. Users buy and sell virtual shares in real UK Members of Parliament. All portfolios, balances, and trades are entirely virtual. No real money is deposited, transferred or withdrawn at any point.

Politex is not a financial product, investment service or gambling product. Share prices are driven by a composite Influence Score derived from publicly available parliamentary and media data. Nothing on the Platform constitutes financial advice or a recommendation to buy or sell any real-world asset.

3. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old to use Politex. By creating an account you confirm that you meet this requirement.

You must not use the Platform if you are located in a jurisdiction where doing so would be unlawful.

4. Account Registration

To use Politex you must create an account by providing a valid email address, a username and a password. You are responsible for:

- Keeping your login credentials confidential
- All activity that occurs under your account
- Notifying us immediately at admin@politex.uk if you suspect unauthorised access

You may only hold one account. Creating multiple accounts to gain an unfair advantage is prohibited.

5. Virtual Platform — No Real Money

All balances on Politex are virtual. Your starting balance of £500 is fictitious and has no monetary value. Shares in MPs have no monetary value. Any gains or losses in your virtual portfolio do not represent real financial gains or losses.

We do not accept real-money deposits. We do not make real-money payments. Nothing on the Platform creates an entitlement to any real-world payment.

If we introduce real-money features in the future, those features will be governed by separate terms and applicable regulation.

6. Acceptable Use

You agree not to:

- Use the Platform for any unlawful purpose
- Attempt to manipulate prices or game the Platform in a way that undermines other users
- Create multiple accounts or use automated tools to gain an unfair advantage
- Reverse engineer, scrape or copy any part of the Platform without our written consent
- Upload or transmit any malicious code, spam or harmful content
- Impersonate any person or organisation
- Harass, abuse or threaten other users

We reserve the right to suspend or terminate accounts that violate these rules, at our sole discretion, without notice.

7. Intellectual Property

All content on the Platform - including the Politex brand, the Influence Score methodology, the platform design and all software - is owned by or licensed to Ludus Games Ltd. You may not reproduce, distribute or create derivative works from any part of the Platform without our prior written consent.

Data about MPs (names, constituency, voting records, Hansard contributions) is derived from publicly available sources including the UK Parliament API and is used in accordance with the Open Parliament Licence.

8. Platform Availability

We aim to keep Politex available at all times but do not guarantee uninterrupted access. We may suspend the Platform for maintenance, updates or circumstances beyond our control without notice.

We reserve the right to modify, suspend or discontinue any feature of the Platform at any time.

9. Disclaimers

The Platform is provided "as is" and "as available" without warranties of any kind, express or implied. We do not warrant that:

- The Platform will be error-free or uninterrupted
- The Influence Scores accurately reflect the real-world standing of any MP
- Any strategy or approach used on the Platform will produce similar results in any real-world market

Nothing on the Platform constitutes financial, investment, legal or political advice.

10. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Ludus Games Ltd shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special or consequential loss arising from your use of the Platform, including but not limited to loss of data, loss of profits or loss of virtual portfolio value.
